



REACH Policy

REACH

REACH is a European Community Regulation on chemicals and their safe use. It deals with the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemical substances. The law entered into force on 1st June 2007, the list of REACH chemicals has been updated on the 17th January 2023. The goal of REACH is to improve the protection of human health and the environment through the better and earlier identification of the intrinsic properties of chemical substances.

The European Chemical Agency identifies SVHCs (Substances of Very High Concern) as potentially harmful. Currently the European Chemicals Agency identifies 233 entries to the SVHCs list. In accordance with Article 33 in the REACH regulation, it is OSPLs duty to state whether or not the products we supply contain articles with SVHCs over the 0.1% threshold.

REACH Statement

OSPL endeavours to only purchase equipment and substances used in its manufacturing process from organisations that can demonstrate that they themselves act responsibly and comply with the EU directive (REACH).

Upon reviewing the European Chemicals Agency's latest SVHC list of 233 potentially harmful substances with our suppliers, OSPL finds no concern to our products at this time.

OSPL will always strive to eliminate substances of concern in its products and product manufacturing process by choosing designs and materials that avoid the use of substances of concern.
